Connect to Re:Guest

You are just a few steps away from connecting your apaleo with Re:Guest.

1. Ask the Re:Guest support team for the unique connection link.
2. Make sure you are logged in into your apaleo account and open the link. Close the popup window “Create client from link” and click on the Save button at the end of the page.



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
3. Your client id and client secret will be shown in a popup window. Write down the codes and pass them to the Re:Guest support team.
